

NAVI MUMBAI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT PRIVATE LIMITED (NMIAL)

Procurement Policy for Supply of Goods and Services

1. Objective:

NMIAL shall procure contracts, goods and services for the construction and operation of the Navi Mumbai International Airport (NMIA) in a fair, transparent and efficient manner, and without any undue favour or discrimination.

2. Purpose:

This Policy specifies the principles to be followed in awarding contracts for supply of goods and services.

3. Policy:

3.1. Non-Related Party Transactions

NMIAL shall adhere to the following principles in respect of any of the Non-Related Party Transactions:

Contract Value (INR)	Procurement Method	Evaluation Method
Upto 25 Crore	Limited/ Single Tender	Evaluation and award will be carried out as per the approved Delegation of Authority
Above 25 Crore	Open Competitive Tender by means of e-tendering (Single Stage or Two Stage)	

3.2. Related Party Transactions

NMIAL shall adhere to the principles laid out in the Concession Agreement dated 8th January 2018 executed between NMIAL and CIDCO and provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 for any Related Party Transactions.

3.3. Procurement from Passenger Service Fee (Security Component)

Any procurement from Passenger Service Fee (Security Component) shall be as per Standard Operating Procedure and directions issued by Ministry of Civil Aviation or any other relevant authority from time to time.

4. Changes in the Policy:

This Policy may be amended, modified or expanded in scope as may be considered appropriate. Any such change shall be made with prior approval of the Competent Authority and with information to the Board of Directors.
